

### Topic

#### **Autumn Term 1: Topic: 'All About Me'**

During this half term, we are learning about ourselves. This will include learning about one another, our families and parts of the body (senses). We will also be looking at what we need to do in order to stay healthy. Our main focus story will be 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' - which we will also link to PSED.

#### **Autumn Term 2 - Light and Dark + Christmas**

During Autumn Term 2, we will be learning about 'Light and Dark'. We will be developing our understanding of opposites and the nocturnal animals. We will also be carrying out lots of activities linked to Christmas.

### **Phonics**

This term we will begin to work through the Read Write Inc scheme on a daily basis.

### **Literacy**

The children will focus on writing their names and other simple words. They will begin to practise to write words, phrases and short sentences. They will also be developing their knowledge of the story of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears', 'Beware of the Bears', 'Peace at Last' and 'Mog and Meg' stories.

### **Maths**

We will be following the key objectives in the EYFS (Mathematics). This will cover:

- Number rhymes and one to one correspondence
- Number recognition
- Counting to 20
- Shape
- Days of the Week
- Counting and Number recognition
- Length
